To the Graduate and his Parents:

James Monroe PTA is happy to announce that it will again sponsor an all-night party at Disneyland for members of the graduating class on Friday June 16. As this is a class party, students should not feel that they must have a date, but dates are welcomed as long as they adhere to the rules and have consent slips signed by their parents or their date's parents. Please read the followings items:

1. Tickets are \$11.00 each. This includes admission, bus transportation and security guards on the Monroe parking lot all night.
 2. Hours for the party will be from 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Buses will return to Monroe about 6 a.m. Saturday.
 3. You may come stag or with a date. Boys may not invite boys as their guests, nor may girls invite girls. Do not plan to meet your date at Disneyland; if he or she attends another school, make arrangements to go on the same bus.
 4. Dress code for students and their dates is as follows:
Gentlemen - Appropriate attire: dress shirt and tie; suit coat or sport coat; dress slacks and dress shoes.
INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE - sandals and canvas shoes; jackets and sweaters (including turtlenecks and letter sweaters).
Ladies - Appropriate attire: date dress; mini, midi and maxi; coordinated pantsuits and slack suits (not separates). Dress shoes (high heels and boots are optional).
INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE: hot pants, slacks, capris and capri sets, hip huggers, jeans, jumpsuits, culottes, mumus.
- These are Disneylands rules. Anyone not dressed accordingly and IN GOOD TASTE will not be allowed to attend. The time required to board the bus will be greatly shortened if we are not asked to discuss policies and standards.
5. All students must go to and from the party by bus.
 6. No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be allowed. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not board the bus.
 7. Buses will load as soon as possible after graduation. Each person will be assigned to a bus when the ticket is purchased, and he must report to that bus, both at school and on the return trip. If you wish to double-date or go with a group, be sure to buy your tickets at the same time. This is the only way to assure seating on the same bus. Before boarding the buses, please do not exchange tickets under any circumstances, as this delays our loading and departure. Do not go home after graduation. Buses should leave school grounds by 9:15 to 9:30. The buses will not be kept waiting for late-comers.
 8. Each guest may have a free souvenir photo taken in Disneyland. When you receive your ticket and photo card on the bus, fill out the photo card completely and legibly, as it is the mailing label.
 9. All park attractions which normally operate during after-dark hours will be in operation, and all guests may enjoy unlimited rides. The only exception to the free attractions will be the shooting galleries.
 10. All food and refreshment facilities will be open. In addition to the regular menus, the restaurants will serve a complete meal, their Grad-Night Special for \$1.00.
 11. From May 27 until June 9 tickets will be on sale daily at nutrition and lunch at the student store.
 12. Chaperones will be on duty at Chaperone Headquarters during the entire party should any problem arise.
 13. Consent slips for all students under 18 must be completely filled out and signed so they can be collected at the time of ticket purchase.
