SUBJECT: SCHEDULE TO BE FOLLOWED DURING THE STRIKE

April 13, 1970

Approximately seventy-five percent of the Monroe teachers did not report for work this morning. Those who did report cannot possibly handle the total student population. The plan below has been worked out to permit those teachers who have reported to carry on a realistic and viable education program for their classes. Few students will have a full program. Most will have at least one class. Many will have no classes at all. In order to avoid large numbers of unsupervised students on campus, and to permit an educational program in the classes of teachers who are present, only two periods will meet each day as follows:

MONDAY, APRIL 13, 1970. Period II will meet from 8:10 until 10:10. Nutrition will follow as usual. Period II classes will meet again from 10:36 to 11:28. Period V will meet from 11:36 to 12:28. Lunch will follow as usual. Period V classes will meet again from 1:18 to 3:10.

TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 1970. Period I will meet from 8:10 to 10:10. Nutrition will follow as usual. Period I will meet again from 10:36 to 11:28. Period IV will meet from 11:36 to 12:28. Lunch will follow as usual. Period IV classes will meet again from 1:18 to 3:10.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 15, 1970. Period III will meet from 8:10 to 10:10. Nutrition will follow as usual. Period III classes will meet again from 10:36 to 11:28. Period VI will meet from 11:36 to 12:28. Lunch will follow as usual. Period VI classes will meet again from 1:18 to 3:10.

This schedule will be repeated every third day, i.e. Thursday, April 16, periods II and V. Friday, April 17, periods I and IV. Monday, April 20 periods III and VI.

The library will be open beginning Tuesday.

Odin's Hall will be open as a study hall beginning Tuesday.

The Student Store will be open.

TA's of teachers present should report to their teachers.

The cafeteria will be open for service at nutrition and lunch.

All student office workers in the main office and girls' gym will be expected to report.

Students are to come only when they know that a teacher will be present, and are to return home or go to the library or to Odin's Hall and lunch area if they have no classes. If and when additional teachers report to work, it will be announced to those students in school. It is hoped that they will help to inform others.

All students should report for school Tuesday morning. We will meet in the quad for instructions at that time.
